A journey encompassing 8,000 km / 5,000 miles spread out over 37 days didn't leave much room for manoeuvre, and the chastity device left even less room. So how did Al find his journey?

"Overall, my biggest challenge was the language barrier. I can speak little more than a smattering of Bahasa (Indonesia's national language) and misunderstandings were a predictable feature of every day. This cost me time and money on many occasions. But, by applying mental determination, I overrode this thought each time it arose because I knew that giving up would herald me as less than the man I truly am."

"Wearing the CB-X Male Chastity device made me feel like a traveller with an important purpose. Indeed my journey became just that, because Indonesian media began publishing my aim as showing that a foreign white man can visit this nation and enjoy themselves without engaging in sex tourism. As media spread this message, I proceeded with confidence because I was helping to make a statement of importance here. It is well known that Indonesians don't appreciate their country being viewed as a sleazy destination, and I agree with that. This aside, I was enjoying the public attention for the sake of another world record attempt; I'm into that at any time!" "I landed myself in a few adventures too, and they're how I'll remember this great hitchhiking trip. The Indonesian police were so lovely to me, delicious foods were cheap and plentiful, and I enjoyed spending time in some spectacular nature. People everywhere came across as genuine and generous, and their welcomes meant I was presented with opportunity. Crossing from Singkawang to Kuching turned out to be a great time in the mud at night, and visiting Tabin Wildlife Reserve was a wonderful respite from travel on main roads. These and more experiences like them came my way, I'm sure, because of the hospitality of the communities I passed through. People and what they do, I think, is a major determinant of how a visitor interprets a place they visit for the first time. That's left me with this impression of Borneo and its surrounding regions: I like it."

"Throughout my journey, I attracted comments. A passenger on the Surabaya-Banjarmasin ocean crossing wrote me a letter of admiration, ladies in all three nations comprising Borneo asked to take photos with me and some wanted to shake my hand or be hugged, and I heard the term "he's crazy" so many times I soon learned how to say that in Bahasa. Men and women alike stared at me with great suspicion and some questioned me harshly as if I was under interrogation. I was constantly amused by the never-ending varied reactions of the public."

"My closing thoughts on what I've just done are numerous. I'm extremely pleased I had the opportunity to venture across Borneo, an island I've longed to see for years, and enjoyed the hospitality of its inhabitants. It's certainly clarified my impressions of the place as far as its environmental stability, level of development and social dynamics are concerned. Upon concluding the event in Banjarmasin, media has distributed considerable coverage of what I embarked on - I'm pleased because this is an excellent way of having more interest in my activities created."
